Ms. Barazzoni is director general of the Technical Secretariat of the Unit for the Simplification and Quality of Regulation, in the Department of Legal Affairs at the Presidency of the Council of Ministers. In 2005-2006, she worked as an administrator at the OECD Public Governance Directorate, Regulatory Policy Division, seconded by the Italian government. In 2001-2002, she worked as an advisor to the United Nations' Department of Economics and Social Affairs (DESA). In 2000, she was appointed as a high-level civil servant to the Presidency of the Council of the Ministers. Since then, she has been in charge of the units for International Affairs, Innovation Policies, and Simplification, Codification and Quality of Regulation.

Between 1996 and 1999, Ms. Barazzoni worked at the Direction Générale de l'Administration et de la Fonction Publique in France, at the European Commission's Internal Market Directorate and as a competition lawyer in the international law firm Cleary, Gottlieb, Steen & Hamilton in Brussels. She holds an LLB from the Università degli Studi di Bologna in Italy, an LLM degree in European Comparative Public Law from the Université Paris I Panthéon-Sorbonne in France and an LLM degree in Trade Regulation from the New York University School of Law in the US.
