Pierre Guislain is the Director of the Investment Climate department in the World Bank Group, General Manager of FIAS and Business Line Leader in the IFC's Business Enabling Environment advisory services. The work of FIAS and IFC/BEE focuses primarily on regulatory simplification (building on the demand created by the Doing Business reports) and on investment policy and promotion. In January 2007, MIGA's board decided to integrate the Agency's technical assistance activities on investment promotion into FIAS. Guislain joined the World Bank Group in 1983 and worked successively in the West Africa Projects Department, the Legal Department, the Asia Technical Department, and the Private Sector Advisory Services Department, before moving to Brussels to manage a joint program between the World Bank and the European Commission on Private Sector Participation in Infrastructure in the Southern Mediterranean region (1997-2001). From 2001 to 2005, he managed the Bank's Information and Communication Technologies division. Guislain is author and editor of several publications on information and communication technology, foreign direct investment, infrastructure sector reform, and privatization. He holds an MPA in Economics and Public Policy from Princeton University and a graduate law degree from the University of Louvain.
