Branimir Gvozdenovic is a Minister of Economic Development in the Government of the Republic of Montenegro. He was born in Bar, where he graduated from the Electro-Technical Faculty. In the period of 2003 to 2006 he held the position of Deputy Prime Minister of Montenegro for Economic Policy and Development.
