Anthony Kleitz is Senior Trade Counselor in the Directorate for Trade and Agriculture of the OECD in Paris. Since March 1995, he has also been Head of the Division on Trade Liberalization and Regulatory issues and as such has led a team of analysts studying a wide range of trade policy issues, including trade-related regulatory reform, non-tariff barriers and aspects of regional trading agreements. Prior to his current positions, he worked in OECD mainly on trade relations between developed and developing countries. He has also taught economics on the American University, as well as the Graduate Overseas Program of Boston University, both in Paris. Anthony Kleitz has received his PhD in 1973 from the Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy at Tufts University in Boston, following earlier studies at the Graduate Institute of International Studies (HEI) in Geneva.
