Ahmet Mancellari is professor of Managerial Economics, MBA Program at Tirana University, sponsored by University of Nebraska, USA, starting from 1998 to date. He was affiliated on part-time bases as an external expert at the ACIT (Albanian Centre for International Trade), a project of the Institute for Contemporary Studies, sponsored by USAID, as Lecturer in Political Economy (Capitalism), Faculty of Economics and University of Tirana. He was also a teacher in a high school, Korça District, Albania, and the head of school in 1980 and 1981. In 1991 and 1992 he was vice dean of Faculty of Economics, University of Tirana. During the period of 2000 to 2002, he was head of Economics Department, Faculty of Economics, University of Tirana and in the period from 1995–2003, he was a head of Microeconomics Sector, department of Economics, University of Tirana. Starting from 1991 he made several study visits, summer schools and qualifications programs in western universities, such as Strathclyde University (UK), University of Kent at Canterbury (UK), Staffordshire University (UK), University of Bari (Italy), University of Nebraska (US), Bamberg University (Germany). His fields of interest in research have been transition reforms, labor market and emigration, trade, business environment and investments and poverty. He is author or co-author in textbooks for the students of the economics, such as Introductory Economics and International Trade.
